Title:	Approval to Award a Contract for the ' East Lancashire Recovery Orientated Adult Substance Misuse Treatment Service'
Summary:	Drug and alcohol misuse are key determinants of health inequalities and levels of crime. The Government estimates that the social and economic cost of Class A drugs is £15 billion and of alcohol misuse, £20 billion per annum. Reducing levels of drug and alcohol misuse will improve health outcomes and reduce offending behaviour; one of the key components of the response to the problem being the commissioning of effective treatment services.
