

## Statutory Notice of Forthcoming Executive Key Decision taken under the provisions of Standing Order 26

<b>Title:</b>	Assessment of Applications for the Countryside Sites and Implications for the County Council
<b>Summary:</b>	<p>Report on the outcome of an assessment of applications to own or operate the County Councils countryside sites, together with recommendations on the next steps, including the retention of some sites.</p> <p>Compliance with SO26 was not possible, the reason for this is that the proposals were not sufficiently advanced to allow publication of a notification 28 days in advance as required under SO25. In addition, there is an immediate need to inform five organisations that site leases will potentially transfer to them and they can begin to plan for the new financial year from April.</p>
