<b>Summary:</b>	<p>In accordance with the county council's procurement rules approval is required to commence the following procurement exercises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) provision of a food distribution network</li> <li>(ii) provision of superfast broadband services</li> <li>(iii) Extra Care Schemes</li> </ul> <p>The following exercise has since been added:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(iv) The Collection, Transportation and Treatment of Wood Waste from 15 Household Waste Recycling and Reuse Centres in the Administrative County of Lancashire.</li> </ul> <p>The exercise set out at (iv) is deemed to be a Key Decision and the provisions of Standing Order No. C20 have been complied with. Compliance with Standing Order No. C19 was impracticable because this exercise was not known to the county council at the time of the 28 days notification being published. This exercise needs to be included in the August report in order to meet the timeframes on the current contract expiring.</p>
