

## Statutory Notice of Forthcoming Executive Key Decision under the provisions of Standing Order 27

<b>Title:</b>	Colne, Lord Street Primary School - Dry Rot Remedial Work
<b>Summary:</b>	<p>Approval is sought to increase the funding for the on-going dry rot remedial works.</p> <p>This is deemed to be a Key Decision and compliance with Standing Orders 25 and 26, where a notification is required to be published 28 days in advance, and the report published for five clear working days, was impracticable due to the reasons stated below.</p> <p>This decision is urgent and cannot await the next meeting of Cabinet on 10 August 2017 for reasons set out in the report. It is therefore proposed that this decision is taken on behalf of Cabinet by the Leader of the Council and the Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Schools, in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 34(1).</p>
