

## Statutory Notice of Forthcoming Executive Key Decisions and Intention to Conduct Business in Private

The following decisions are due to be taken by Cabinet on **1 December 2022**

<b>Title:</b>	A601(M) Maintenance Project
<b>Summary:</b>	The funding of the A601(M) bridge and highway maintenance scheme was approved by Cabinet in July 2020. The report set out that the allocation should address the lowest cost option for maintenance of the A601(M) over a 30-year period and highlighted the replacement of Higher North Road bridge with an at grade junction as a means of achieving this. After a full review of the project cost it was found that the estimated cost of the new junction had increased significantly due to construction inflation adversely affecting the activities associated with that part of the project. It is now proposed to retain and maintain Higher North Road bridge and deliver the other key features of the project such as, reduced speed limit, revoking motorway status, removal of hard shoulders returning them to green verge, addressing surfacing, road markings/signing as well as other remedial and safety enhancements.
