ASD/ADHD children and young people involved with TAAG cannot access mainstream settings easily and so require tailor made groups to meet their needs. The project is needed to bridge the gap in provision. The project will address the gap in social care provision for children and young people with ASC/ADHD locally. It will recognise the need for high quality, supported opportunities for children and young people with impaired social and communication skills to recognise they own challenges and be better able to meet them.
