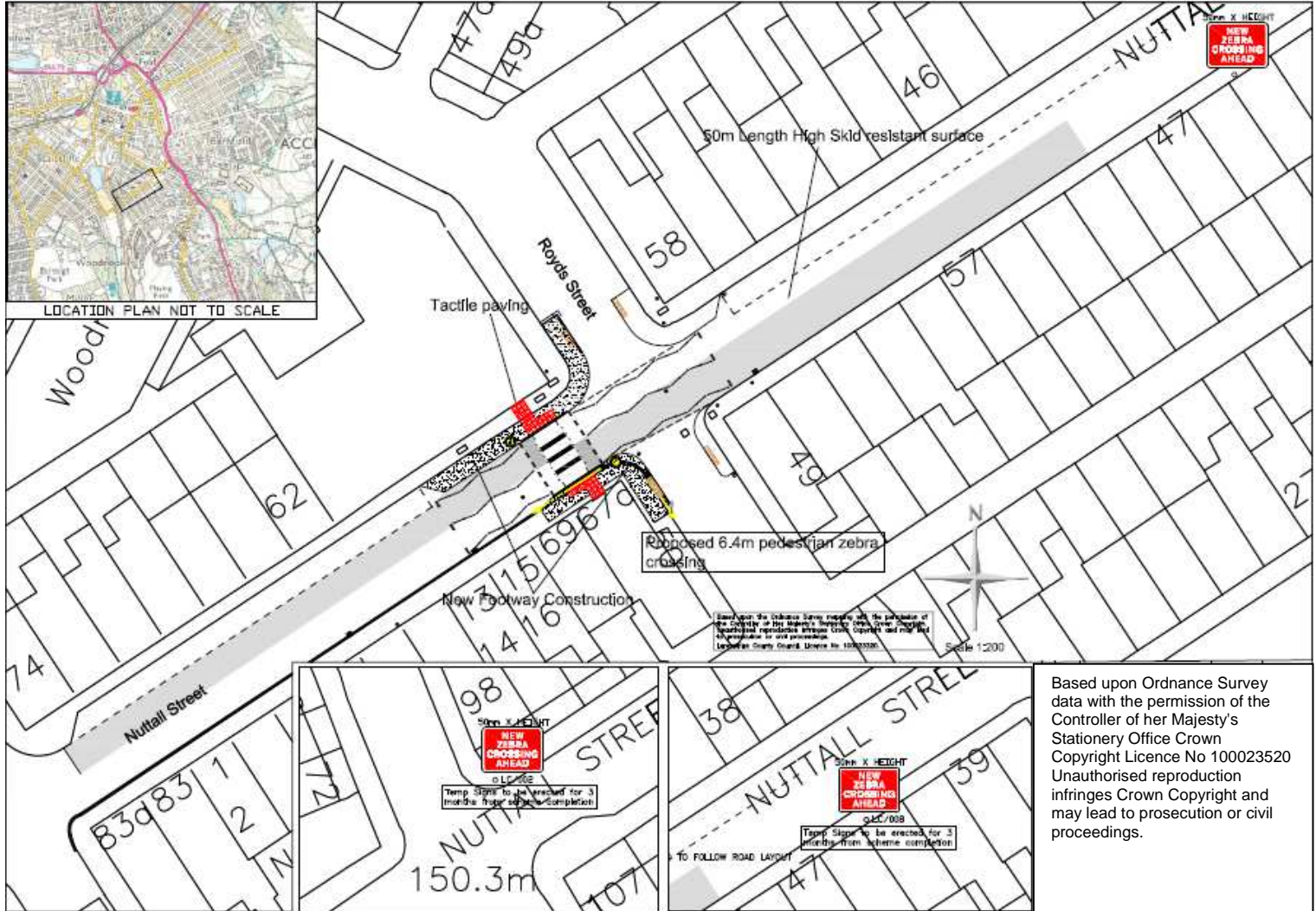


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(NUTTALL STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)**  
**(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Nuttall Street, Accrington, from a point 46 metres east of Edmund Street, to its junction with Royds Street.



**Statement of reason**

Zebra crossing is proposed in order to increase the safety of pedestrians (particularly vulnerable young children or less mobile elderly pedestrians) crossing the carriageway. The crossing is proposed within close proximity to the nearby primary school, nursery and place of worship because this creates an increase in the amount of pedestrians wishing to cross the carriageway at this location – it is positioned at the optimum desire line but at the safe distance from the conflicting traffic movements of the Royds Street junction.
