

# What good practice says about the role of elected members

#### versal - all councillors should

- Understand the legal/ policy framework
- Know the profile of local children and how well they are doing
- Consider the needs of looked after children in all decisions
- geted councillors with relevant role e.g. member of scrutiny committee or Corporate Parenting
- Consider the effectiveness of local arrangements
- Consider range of evidence in order to identify what needs to change
- cialist councillors with leadership role should
- Constantly drive improvements to the service
- Make sure that the needs of looked after children are incorporated in all
- council/ partner strategies
- Keep up to date with research findings and new initiatives

### What the law says ....

For looked after children and care levers....

- Act in the best interests and promote the health and wellbeing of those children and young people
- To encourage those children and young people to express their views, wishes and feelings
- To take into account the views, wishes and feelings of those children and young people
- To help those children and young people gain access to, and make the best use o, services provided by the local authority and its relevant partners



## To promote high aspirations, and seek to secure the best stockers, for those children and young people

For those children and young people to be safe, and for stability their home lives, relationships and education or work

To prepare those children and young people for adulthood and dependent living




