**Title of Report:** Colne, Lord Street Primary School – Dry Rot Remedial Works

#### **Brief Description:**

Proposals for the funding of on-going dry rot remedial works at Colne, Lord Street Primary School.

This is deemed to be a Key Decision and the provisions of Standing Order No. 27 have been complied with.

#### **Recommendation:**

The Leader of the County Council and the Cabinet Member for Children, Young People and Schools approved the recommendation as set out in the full report.
