WE WORK WITH THE CENTRAL LANCASHIRE TREATMENT SERVICES, TAKING REFERRALS. WE HAVE ALSO JUST FORMED LINKS WITH LANCASHIRE CARE NHS FOUNDATION TRUST "COMMUNITY RESTART RICHMOND FELLOWSHIP MAKING RECOVERY REALITY SUPPORTING HEALTH AND WELLBEING" AND THEY ARE GOING TO SIGNPOST PEOPLE WITH ALCOHOL MISUSE PROBLEMS TO US. WE PROMOTE AND SUPPORT ALL ACTIVITIES THAT OFFER AN IMPROVED QUALITY OF LIFE, INCLUDING SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AND EDUCATION.
