As winners we have the opportunity to compete against the best 4th Section bands from around the UK at the National Brass Band Championships of Great Britain 2017 to be held on 16th September at Cheltenham. Raising the standard of musicianship through competition improves the performances of concerts, encourages new members of all ages and enhances the general public's appreciation of our concerts which has been recognised by our audiences and encourages all players in their confidence and music skills.

Our regular Thornton Little Theatre Concerts give the local community an opportunity to see and hear a broad spectrum of popular music and to help encourage support and fund the continued tuition of people of any age in the art of making music. By aiding this support the local community are helping to sustain the local provision of a music educational resource where social inclusion is encouraged for anyone, any age, any ability along with our junior band both run by local musicians/volunteers where all funds are put back into the band for its long term existence. We have been registered as a Charity by the Charity Commission since May 1975 - registration No 501608.

By engaging with the community we help maintain an essential fundraising source to continue the provision of musical tuition we strive to provide.

We provide free brass instruments, a safe environment and meet regularly to rehearse in a dedicated purpose built rehearsal building at the Bands own building on Holly Road Thornton.
