Arts Lancashire are responsible for holding the region's only arts and culture conference, an annual event that brings together Lancashire based artists, arts organisations, funders, commissioners and public sector leaders alike with the ultimate goal of raising Lancashire's artistic ambition by focusing thinking on how to further regional and sub-regional strategic aims through arts and culture for the benefit of Lancashire's residents and visitors as well as our regional economy and social value. This year's conference programme includes Jake Berry, Minister for the Northern Powerhouse.

In previous years, the Lancashire Arts Exchange has been supported by funds from Lancashire County Council's Arts Development Service plus the host's borough council. Receiving this this money will enable Arts Lancashire to hold the Lancashire Arts Exchange in the wake of the dissolution of Lancashire County Council's Arts Development Service earlier this year.

Fylde's cultural sector has not been as well developed or well established as other parts of the county and region. As such there have been fewer external funding opportunities. The Arts Exchange is a real opportunity for Fylde's cultural sector to showcase its assets and talents.

Fylde's cultural and artistic organisations have forged a strong alliance through the Fylde Arts Partnership and subsequently with Arts Lancashire and this Lancashire Arts Exchange will bring together and benefit Fylde's arts and culture sector, providing them with opportunities for learning and professional development. It will also provide the opportunity to meet and connect with the cultural sector from across the region. Fylde residents of all ages will be able to access and enjoy an illuminated outdoor performance of 'The Boy Who Grew Wings' in the grounds of Lytham Hall after the Exchange, followed by an afternoon of public workshops in aerial skills, circus skills and storytelling and a second evening performance of 'The Boy Who Grew Wings' in the grounds of Lytham Hall on the Saturday 21st October.

Supporting this event will simultaneously support Fylde Council's developing contemporary arts strategy who view the 'The Boy Who Grew Wings' performances and workshops as an opportunity to augment their contemporary arts event offer to appeal to different audiences and extend their event calendar into Autumn by testing a new type of outdoor programming, whilst supporting one of Fylde's key cultural asset – Lytham Hall – which continues to operate under difficult and reduced circumstances.
