
Following consultation carried out between 07<sup>th</sup> July and 04<sup>th</sup> August 2017, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled below, to amend the restrictions set out in Church Street, Burnley, the effect of which is set out below.



## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BURNLEY, WORTHSTHORNE-WITH-HURSTWOOD AND PADIHAM, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATIONS AND VARIOUS PARKING RESTRICTIONS, MAY (NO. 1)) ORDER 201\*

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- 1) Remove item h from the Order, restriction of waiting 8am 6.30pm, Church Street, Burnley, the west side from a point 164 metres north of the centreline of Keirby Walk to the centreline of School Lane
- 2) Introduce a restriction of waiting from 8am 6.30pm, in Church Street, Burnley, the west side, from a point 164 metres north of the centreline of Keirby Walk to its junction with Rawcliffe Street
- 3) Introduce a restriction of waiting Monday to Saturday, from 8am to 6pm, Church Street, Burnley, the west side, from the centreline of Rawcliffe Street to a point 15 metres north of the centreline of School Lane.
