Burnley

(Venice Street, Burnley – Cog Lane, Burnley – Villiers Street, Burnley – Moorhouse Street, Burnley – Hartley Street, Burnley – Brush Street, Burnley – Hargher Street, Burnley)

"The purpose of this proposed order is to clarify, simplify and tidy up a selections of traffic orders that have been identified in the **Burnley area**. The orders are to improve the safety of all highway users (including pedestrians) whilst providing parking amenities where necessary."

<u>Fylde</u>

(Woodlands Road, Ansdell – Clifton Drive North, St Annes – Clifton Drive South, St Annes – St David's Road South, St Annes – Clegg Street, Kirkham)

"The purpose of this proposed order is to clarify, simplify and tidy up a selections of traffic orders that have been identified in the **Fylde area**. The orders are to improve the safety of all highway users (including pedestrians) whilst providing parking amenities where necessary."

(Lightburne Avenue, St Annes – Clifton Drive South, St Annes – Wood Street, St Annes)

"The purpose of this proposed order is to provide a safe passage of travel for both vehicles and pedestrians"

<u>Hyndburn</u>

(Whitebirk Drive, Rishton)

"It has been agreed that Lancashire County Council will pursue a No Waiting at Any Time Prohibition along a length of the unclassified Whitebirk Drive, Rishton U48115 and its northern spur.

It is proposed to place a Prohibition of waiting along the length of the unclassified Whitebirk Drive U48115 to discourage vehicles from waiting and parking in a location which will obstruct the thoroughfare to vehicles and delivery access to the existing business.

The provision of the proposed NWAAT will ensure adequate visibility splays and manoeuvrability for delivery vehicles entering and exiting the existing business and clear unobstructed passage for all vehicles."

"It has been agreed that Lancashire County Council pursue a No Waiting at Any Time Prohibition along a section of Harwood Lane, Great Harwood.

It is proposed to place a Prohibition of waiting along a section of Harwood Lane on both sides of the carriageway from its junction with the A680 Whalley Road to discourage vehicles from waiting and parking in a location which will obstruct access and block site lines. The provision of the proposed NWAAT will ensure adequate visibility splays and manoeuvrability for vehicles entering and exiting the new development and football ground."

(Hartley Street, Great Harwood)

"It has been agreed that Lancashire County Council pursue a No Waiting at Any Time Prohibition along the length of Hartley Street.

It is proposed to place a Prohibition of waiting along the length of Hartley Street on both sides to discourage vehicles from waiting and parking in a location which will obstruct the delivery access to the existing business. The provision of the proposed NWAAT will ensure adequate visibility splays and manoeuvrability for delivery vehicles entering and exiting the existing business."

Preston
