We are hoping to buy some microphones and ancillary equipment to enhance the facilities at our rehearsal venue and they will also be used for performances at other venues, saving hiring costs. The cost is likely to be £2500+ and therefore we are need to raise some funds. The group gives children and young people the opportunity to take part in theatre productions and have experience of performing on stage before a live audience. Microphones will help to increase the possibilities of what we can do within the group.

The group provides a friendly meeting place; working together, singing, dancing, learning lines promotes positive relationships between young people of different backgrounds, widens their learning experience, encourages an appreciation of the theatre and performing arts and helps them to develop confidence and greater self-esteem.
