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Overview of the IRO Service

- 45 full time equivalent IROs with average of 78 children / young people on their caseload
- Undertake chairing of Child Protection Conferences and Child Looked After Reviews
- Statutory role (IRO Handbook) to monitor the quality of corporate parenting provided to looked after children
- Ofsted (August 2018) inspection highlighted the need to strengthen critical challenge amongst IROs and first line managers



Performance 2018/19

- CLA numbers increased by 7.5% but vast majority receive and take part in a timely review of their care plan
- IROs pushing greater use of 'All About Me' consultation documents
- CP numbers increased by 10% but 95% of reviews were held within timescales
- More children stayed on a plan over 2 years or made subject of a plan for a second time



IRO Challenge & Footprint

- 767 in 17/18 to 1705 in 18/19
- 85% completion of mid-point monitoring by IROs
- Joint training / learning circles with managers to promote consistent understanding of what is 'good'
- IRO Managers undertaking regular audit activity on cases with a focus on impact of IRO involvement on outcomes



Health Assessments & PEPs

- Updated template guidance for the CLA Review to ensure consistent focus
- 85% of looked after children have a Health Assessment, 56% within timescale – project group established to drive this
- 93% of looked after children have a Personal Education Pla (PEP) but only 59% are up to date. PEP process and template updated to strengthen delivery

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Permanence

- Identified by Ofsted (2018) and reflected in improvement plans
- Clearer understanding and tracking of Permanence
- IROs monitoring and driving via CLA Review and within Permanence Panels
- Placement Stability and Disruption Meetings established Life Story Work



Next Steps

- Family Safeguarding Model & Strengths-Based Practice
- Strengthen understanding of 'good' in respect of plans and outcomes / impact
- Build on improved IRO challenge to ensure consistency and evidence of impact on the quality of care / support
- Delivery of Permanence including placement stability, discharge of Care Orders and reunification
- Review of IRO additional duties outside of core function

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
