Our Vision

Moor Park is a very successful outstanding secondary school serving a local and diverse community. The school has developed and improved significantly during the first decade of the new millennium. We became a Foundation School in 2009 and further improvements followed this step resulting in higher standards of achievement and attainment. This was recognised by Ofsted in 2011 who rated the school outstanding overall.

The strategic vision underpinning our Foundation Status is rooted in raising aspirations and achievement for our pupils. The Government recognises the significant role schools play in the success of young people after they leave school at 16. The compulsory school leaving age is due to change as all young people are required to remain in education and training until the age of 19. Schools will therefore be accountable for the progress of all their pupils post 16. The Government have subsequently introduced measures to allow governing bodies to establish post 16 provision. As a result we aim to extend our vision and develop educational provision for our pupils who wish to continue their education in Moor Park in preparation for Higher Education and a successful career.

Our vision is to ensure students in Year 12 and 13 in Moor Park are able to realise their potential and achieve their goals through the provision of post 16 courses that lead to 'A' level and equivalent qualifications alongside a wide range of opportunities designed to provide individual programmes tailored to the academic development and personal needs of each student in preparation for higher education.

Our aim is to establish outstanding post 16 educational provision in Moor Park that will be an all round memorable experience in an inclusive ethos, building on the excellent care, guidance and support provided during Year 10 and 11. Our new purpose built Sixth Form Centre will provide state of the art resources with facilities for personal study and a well-equipped area for students to relax during breaks.

In keeping with our highly regarded inclusive ethos as a school that recognises all faiths and none, students will have access to a multi-purpose faith room for quiet thought, prayer and contemplation. Each student will have a personal tutor who will provide support, information, advice and guidance.

Our ambition is to work in collaboration with other post 16 providers to expand the range of courses and programmes on offer whilst fostering links with Universities and Colleges of Higher Education in order to promote successful progression and ensure our students are successful in their chosen future.

Our excellent partnerships with business, community groups, Lancashire Authority and Preston City Council, combined with a highly professional staff team and dedicated

governing body, committed to seeing students in Moor Park flourish, provides us with the ideal formula to ensure our Foundation Sixth Form benefits the students, the school and the whole community.
