Treasury Management Activity 2021/22

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Executive Summary

The report at Appendix A provides information on the treasury management activity in 2021/22 for the period April to November 2021.

Recommendation

The committee is asked to note the review of treasury management activities.

Background and Advice

The council's treasury management activity is underpinned by the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy's Code of Practice on Treasury Management. This code recommends that a treasury management report for members is produced after the end of each financial year and on activities during the year. Part of the remit of the Audit, Risk and Governance Committee is to oversee treasury management activities.

The report at Appendix A provides information on the activity in 2021/22 for the period April to November 2021.

The report also highlights the high level of economic uncertainty during the year. This has resulted in significant volatility and activity in the bond markets which has been a major factor in enabling the forecast net underspend against the treasury management budgets. The current forecast net underspend against budget for 2021/22 is £13.5m.
