

## **Report to Lancashire SACRE - September 2023**

- 2 new associate RE consultants were appointed in July 2023. Thank you to John and Helen for joining the recruitment panel. There are now 4 consultants in the team although one has started maternity leave. A set of protocols have been written to ensure consistency in practice. The first team meeting will be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> September.
- A new electronic <u>support request click form</u> has been a huge success. 6 schools have requested consultancy support since the start of term.
- Consultants continue to support clusters and trainee teachers e.g. through SCITT, WRIST, Mossgate.
- The autumn term newsletter will be released on 25 September. This will be circulated electronically.
- Wigan have invited the LA officer to present at their Agreed Syllabus Conference. They are currently agreeing on the adoption of a syllabus which will best meet their school's needs.
- 5 secondary schools have been invited to a free training session with Joanne Harris. This is being held on 18<sup>th</sup> October. This is in response to the KS3 RE survey.
