

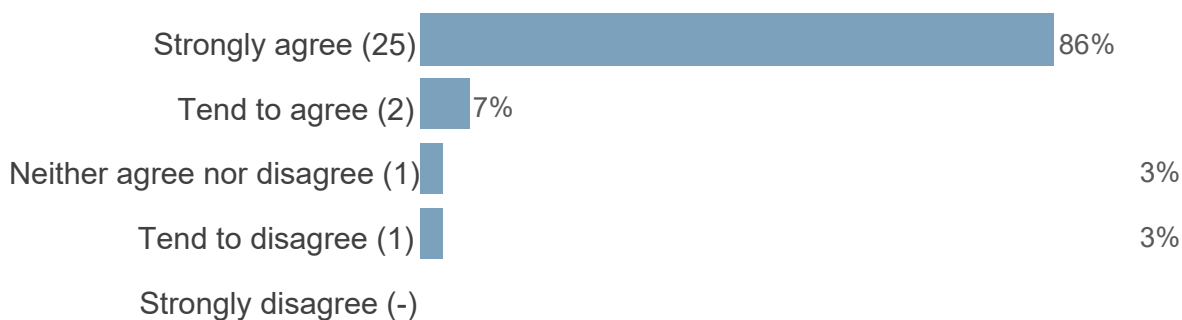
Flakefleet SEN Unit Formal Consultation - Jan 2024

We are proposing to create an SEN unit which will be part of Flakefleet Primary School to support up to sixteen children with social communication and interaction needs

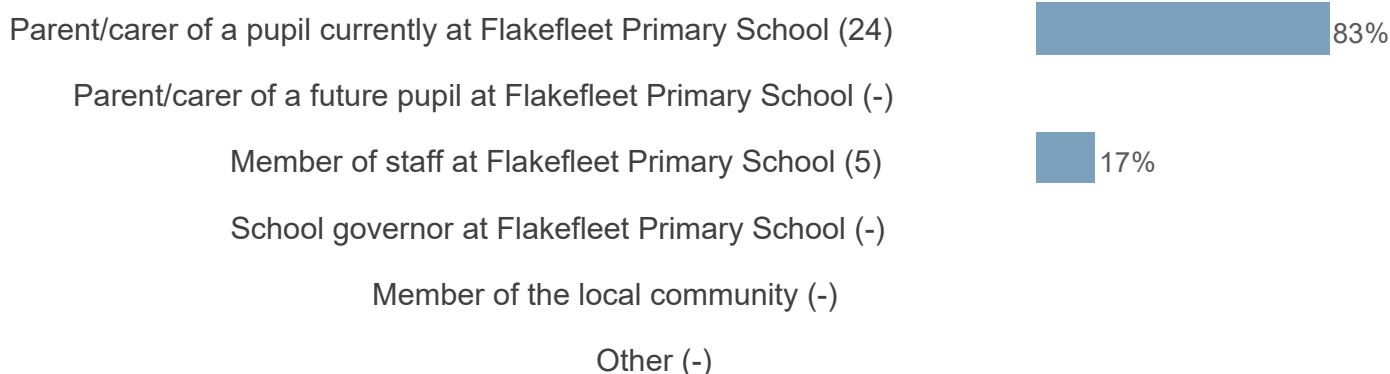
Why do you say this?

- I don't feel like enough schools have the availability to offer this. It would be a massive asset to families
- My son attends flakefleet at present but needs to now attend a sen school on a short term basis. If flakefleet had the capacity to have a sen center then he could stay where he is and they could still meet his needs. This would be amazing for our growing community
- This would be great for the school
- Children with additional needs need more support and more facilities need to be available for children already in the school that don't cope with daily school environment
- As there isn't enough room in special schools for SEN children as they are over crowded and as I have SEN experience from working in a school I feel every school should have an SEN unit to give these children quality of life
- I strongly agree to this decision as we need SEN units to help the children with communication and interaction needs, as all children should be able to receive the right support in education to help their confidence grow, so they can get the support with reading, writing, and challenges that they need in the future.
- More support for existing pupils and more options for families with SEN children can only be beneficial to the community as a whole.
- My concern would be if they will be interacting with children in the classroom and start causing problems then that will disrupt the other children's day learning...
- My 5 year old has special needs
- My daughter has special needs and would benefit from this
- I support the idea on 100% ,so many children need this but there isn't where to go.
- As a parent of 2 children with SEN this is absolutely ideal for me as my children love this school very much
- Due to my son being an SEN child he currently attends this school
- Currently have a SEN child at Flakefleet and feel this would strongly help with his learning
- Ensure that the current pupils without EHCPs are still receiving the additional support they need and the focus of SEN is not solely on the proposed building. Other than this I feel that would be beneficial to the children in our local area.

- my son is really struggling at flakefleet at the moment in his lessons and i think they already provide a great space in nurture but it would be a good idea to have lessons still taking place in a setting like the one proposed
- I agree there needs to be more sen schools about . Myself having a child with needs and I currently can't get him into a special school.
- It depending on the amount of sen needs they are going to meet. As is it only going to be minimum or maximum needs.
- There is a great need for this unit as there is a great shortage for children who need specialist educational support. It will also benefit the children who are able to learn in the mainstream setting as they will have more support from their TAs
- I have worked as a [REDACTED] at Flakefleet for over [REDACTED] years and have seen a steady rise in the amount of SEN children we have. The needs of some of these children are ones we have not encountered before. This is also impacting on the class and the amount of help we as individuals can give. I myself work in the speech and language area and have seen an massive increase in this area within school.

- I feell that the children within the school who have extra needs dont always get the help required

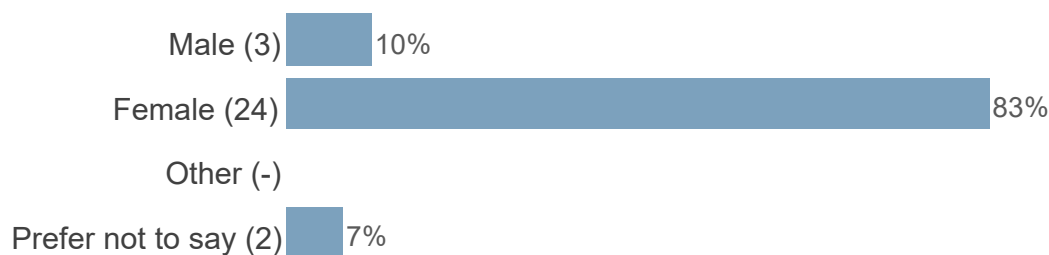

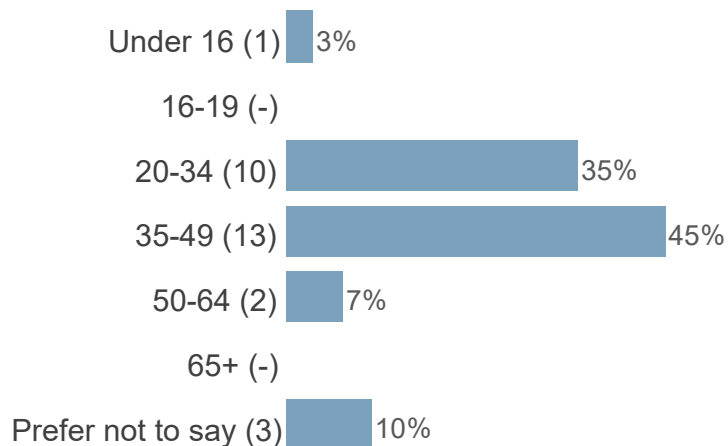

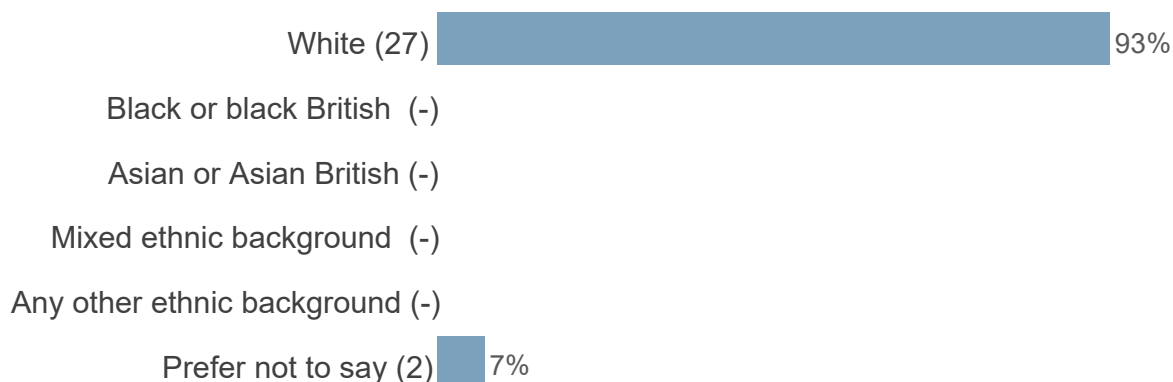
What was your age on your last birthday?

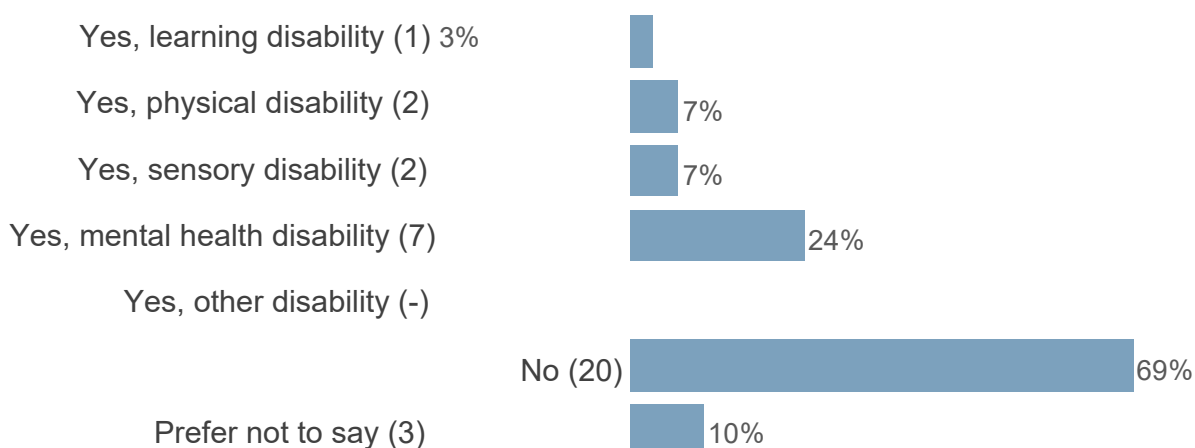
Which of the following best describes your ethnic background?

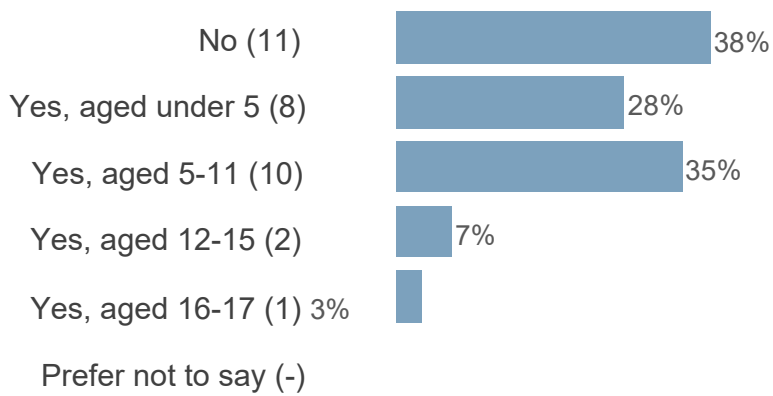


Are you a deaf person or do you have a disability?
