Brief Summary

This report presents an application from an organisation requesting £636.75 to deliver a series of commemorative events in line with national and international events for the 80th anniversary of D-Day from the Champion for Armed Forces and Veterans Budget.

Recommendation

That consideration be given to the request for grant funding as set out in this report.

Detail

The role of Champion was first established in 2002 and the county council currently has six Champions, whose role is to support the Leader and individual Cabinet Members within their remits.

The six county council Champions are as follows:

- Armed Forces and Veterans
- Disabled People
- Mental Health
- Older People
- Parishes
- Young People

For the financial year 2023/24, each Champion has been given an annual allocation of £10,000 for use at their discretion to finance their activities, to which any unspent



balance up to a maximum of £2,500 from the previous financial year could be added, giving a maximum budget of £12,500 in any one financial year. The Champion for Armed Forces and Veterans total budget is set out in the financial section of the report.

They are planning four days of events which will take place on The Green including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 6 June a bonfire and formal service in line with national and international commemorations. - 7 June family Quiz - 8 June all day, large scale event with period entertainment, children's activities, performances from local group, competitions, food and drink stalls, World War II vehicles, reenactors including soldiers, 1940s performances and "The Churchills", vintage stalls and a dining and entertainment evening event which will be ticketed. The Royal British Legion and Soldiers', Sailors' & Airmen's Families Association (SSAFA) – The Armed Forces Charity have been invited to attend the event as our chosen charities. - 9 June family picnic day, community church service on The Green and afternoon Tea
What are the benefits expected to be achieved?
It will be held in Wrea Green and publicised to the wider Fylde Coast area with the support of the Wrea Green Parish Council and Fylde Borough Council Tourism team.



Please give a detailed breakdown of your expenditure for your activity / equipment.

They are seeking funding for the following activities on Saturday 8 June:

Children's activities

Spitfires:

MDF (plywood) spitfires that be painted and taken home as a memento £250 for 100 (the company is providing plywood at cost)

Paints and paint brushes - £17.85

Paratrooper craft for children:

Toy soldiers - £11.90

String - £10

Parachutes (fabric squares) £47 (.47p each for 100) (we will be seeking donations of fabric to reduce this cost)

(Any savings on the above will be used towards additional children's activities such as printing costs for codebreaking and colouring, facepainting etc)

Activities open to everyone:

JEM Events: (A group of three professional singers who will be doing four 1940s performances over a four-hour period singing songs from the era and reciting famous speeches and poetry). A £100 deposit has been paid and the total cost is £900. We are requesting £150 from this fund towards the performers which will be a free performance open to all visitors.

Family Quiz Night – to be held Friday 7 June

£150 for professionally run quiz evening including quizmaster and all technical equipment

If you are not asking for the full amount of the cost of your activity / equipment, please give us details of where the rest of the funding is coming from. Please also explain what you will do if we give you the grant, but you do not get the other funding.
