SACRE Development Plan 2013-15 (2 Years)
Draft priorities for consideration

These priorities have been identified following:

- A review of the current development plan
- Feedback from teachers and headteachers in Lancashire
- Discussion with Young People in Lancashire
- A review of national priorities and developments

1. To fulfil SACRE's statutory role by providing effective leadership of RE and Collective Worship by:

- a) Providing an appropriate Agreed Syllabus and guidance on Collective Worship
- b) Effective communication with schools about the work of SACRE
- c) Monitoring the quality of provision for RE and Collective Worship
- d) Monitoring achievement in RE

2. To raise achievement in RE by:

- a) Ensuring that the Agreed Syllabus is easily accessible and navigable for teachers
- b) Reviewing and augmenting the exemplification materials
- c) Providing opportunities to share and develop good practice
- d) Providing opportunities to connect with different living religious traditions

3. To improve the provision of Collective Worship by:

- a) Ensuring that schools are aware of the support materials and guidance (Mirrors and Doors 2)
- b) Augmenting the exemplification materials
- c) Providing opportunities to share and develop good practice

4. To ensure that the provision of RE is informed by the views of stakeholders by:

- a) Providing opportunities for Children and Young People to participate in the development of RE
- b) Further developing links with people of different faiths, beliefs and traditions
- c) Maintaining links with national bodies who lead on RE
