

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHURCH BANK AND SCHOOL LANE, OVER KELLET, LANCASTER CITY) (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201*

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under **Sections 84(1)(a), and (2)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984** as amended (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. 20mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph along the full length the following lengths of road, in the City of Lancaster:

- i. Church Bank, Over Kellet for its entire lengths of road;
- ii. School Lane, Over Kellet for its entire lengths of road;

(Where appropriate the above speed limit will remove the existing restricted 30mph road status)

2. Exception

"No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations".

3. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the “Lancashire County Council (Church Bank and School Lane, Over Kellet, Lancaster City) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 201*” and shall come into force on the day of ***** 201**”.
