Policy to reduce quantities of non-household waste delivered to Household Waste Recycling Centres

- 1. A vehicle will be able to deposit 10 'items' of soil/rubble and plasterboard free of charge per calendar year by production of an approved permit.
- 2. An 'item' is one 25kg bag of material or a single item as detailed in Appendix B (i), or any other such item of waste that the Council deems to be similar in nature.
- 3. In order to deliver up to 10 items free of charge householders must obtain a permit in advance of a visit to the HWRC.
- 4. A permit will be issued against a vehicle registration on the basis of one permit per vehicle per calendar year.
- 5. A permit must be produced and number of items delivered recorded of the householder will not be allowed to use the facility.
- 6. Upon expiry of the permit or use of all items the permit is to be surrendered to a site attendant.
- 7. All soil/rubble and plasterboard delivered without a permit will be charged at £3.50 per item.
- 8. For soil/rubble and plasterboard carried loose in vehicles the following charging policy shall apply:

Trailers up to 1 metre in length
Trailers up to 2 metre in length
Trailers up to 3 metre in length

£52.50

- 9. Open back vehicles will be charged as above dependant on the size of the carrying area.
- 10. In respect of points 8 and 9 of the policy the site attendant's assessment of the required charge is final.
- 11. Payment will be taken on site by credit or debit card only. Payment by cash or cheque will **not** be accepted.
- 12. This policy is to be effective from 1st April 2015 and the policy and associated charging rates will be reviewed annually.
