Title of Report: Proposed Capital Programme for Regularising Primary School Admission Numbers and Suitability Projects in Mainstream Primary Schools to Address Accommodation Issues as Identified by Ofsted

Brief Description: This report seeks approval of Phase 1 of a programme of capital improvement/expansion projects in maintained and aided schools, including the provision of additional places to regularise admission numbers and address suitability issues as identified by Ofsted.
