Title of Report: Approval to Award Contracts for Care and Support Services in Lancashire Prisons

Brief Description:

In line with the Care Act 2014, Lancashire County Council is responsible for delivering social care in prisons. Earlier this year the County Council entered into a partnership with NHS England to conduct a joint procurement exercise (led by NHS England) and the report sets out the results of this procurement exercise.

This is deemed to be a Key Decision and the provisions of Standing Order No 25 have been complied with.
