<b>Title:</b>	Decommissioning of Dispersed Accommodation Support Service in Preston
<b>Summary:</b>	<p>A decision is being sought to decommission a Lancashire County Council funded dispersed visiting support service provided across the Preston area.</p> <p>Following a period of consultation the proposal is to cease funding by mutual agreement on 29 November 2015 or as soon as possible thereafter.</p> <p>It is proposed to de-commission the service for the following reasons:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Delivery of budget savings</li><li>• Alternative support services are available</li><li>•</li></ul>
