8. Impact of Partnership Working on School Improvement

The Cabinet Committee requested a report on the outcomes of a risk assessment of low attaining schools who have fallen below the Floor Standards at the end of Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 4. In order to carry out this assessment process effectively further detailed school level information needs to be gathered on schools' performance in 2012. The data on pupil progress in primary schools is an important component of the Floor Standard but we have now been informed that this is not available until December 2012. The Secondary school performance information will not be available until early January. In order to carry out accurate risk assessments using the full range of performance data, it has therefore been agreed that this report to the Cabinet Committee be postponed to a later date until the relevant data is available in January 2013.
