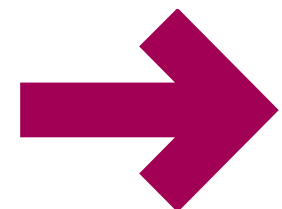
## Lancashire Screening and Immunisation update

Provide an oversight of uptake at a Lancashire level of screening and Immunisation programmes

- **Focus on the national 0-5 years, school aged HPV and the seasonal influenza immunisation programmes**
- **The three national cancer screening programme**

Please note that underlying all the programmes is variation of uptake at provider, practice CCG level.

Actions taken to improve uptake vary in accordance to programme and evidence.



## Organisational responsibility across Screening and Immunisation Programmes

### NHS England (Lancashire)

- Commission section 7a services to meet national service specifications this includes uptake to meet local population needs

### Clinical Commissioning Groups

- Ensure quality of services provided by their primary care practices
- Collaboration in the commissioning of services which involve section 7a programmes

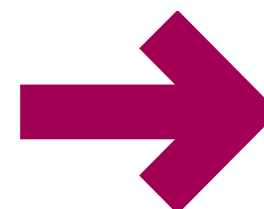
### Local Authority

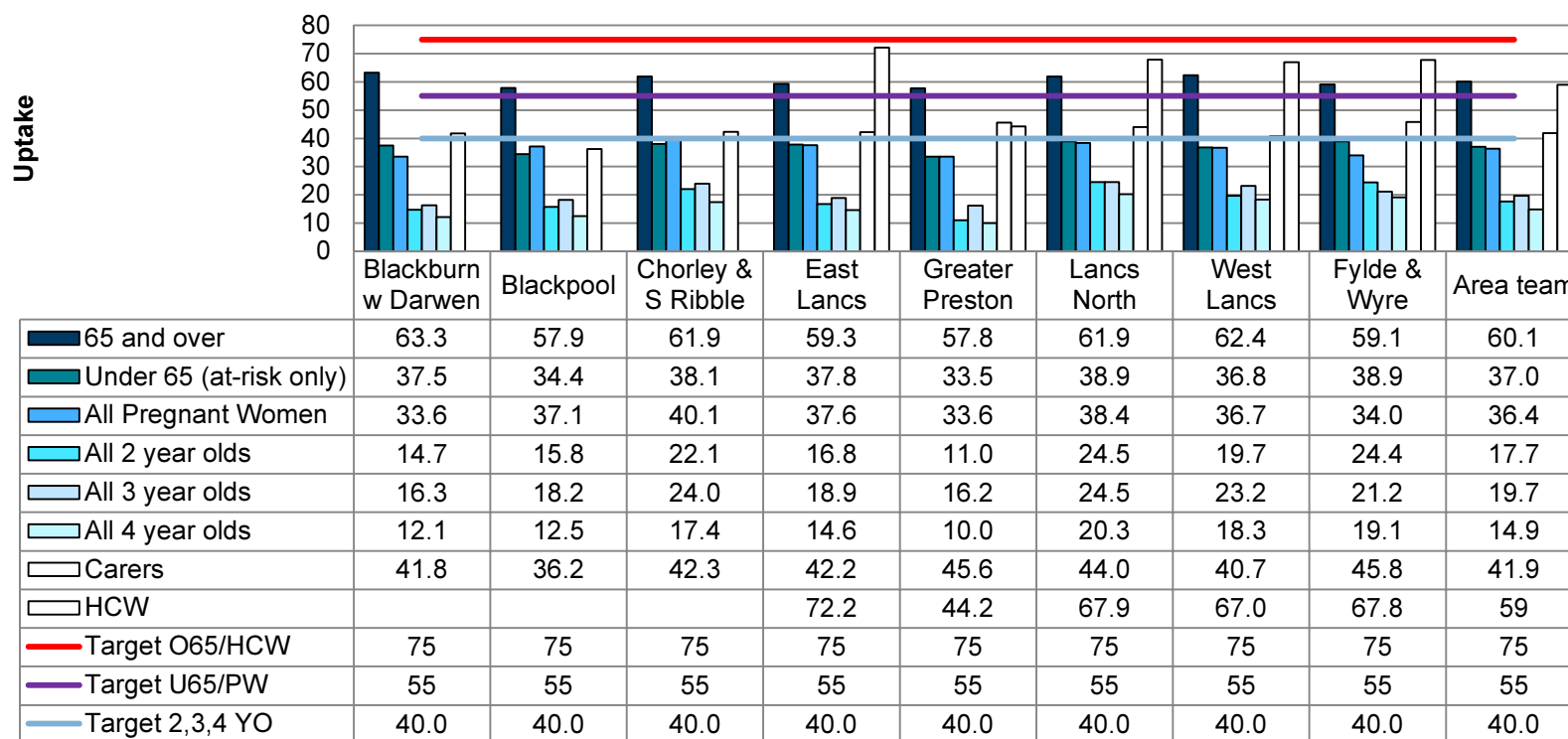

# Collaborative action

## Collaboratively support – The Lancashire cancer plan;

### Breast Screening

- The Breast Screening Lancashire communications plan in partnership with the Lancashire breast screening units trust communications teams

### Bowel

- The forthcoming “Be Clear on Cancer bowel cancer screening” campaign running across the Granada region from early January to early April. The first 6 weeks is a media only campaign- TV/ Billboards/ bus stop advertising. Can the team work with LCC to promote the campaign on the library TV's/ within care homes/ Social services?

### Cervical

- NHS England Lancashire are currently developing a campaign to target first timers (25 year olds) we would seek support in utilising opportunities to promote the campaign i.e. children's centres

## Immunisation Programmes

Provide consistent messages regarding the importance of the immunisations programmes and work with us to assure quality services for patient's In particular;

- Promote flu vaccination in particular in those aged 2, 3 and 4 years of age
- Uptake among 5 year old for Pre school Booster and 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR remain low, support required in ensuring children are starting school without any outstanding immunisations
- Promote the school HPV programme and engagement with head teachers regarding the importance of all school aged immunisation programmes

## Across all programme

- Utilise opportunities when liaising with local employers through business forums to encourage promotion of programmes and flexibility in enabling people attending screening/immunisation appointments.
- Support the development of a Lancashire stakeholder screening and immunisation inequalities strategy
- Support the Screening and Immunisation oversight Group – Identify a key lead person to attend and contribute.

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
