## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS LOCATIONS, WYRE, PENDLE, ROSSENDALE AND FYLDE BOROUGHS, AND PRESTON CITY) (REVOCATIONS, VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS AND ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING POINTS (NO2)) ORDER 201\*

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,** as amended, the effect of which will be to:

## 1. Revoke the following:

- a. The "Lancashire County Council (Pendle Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to Item (76) a) (i) of Schedule 10.01;
- b. The "Lancashire County Council (Preston Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
  - i. Item (12) b) of Schedule 11.009;
  - ii. Item (2) of Schedule 12.028.
- c. The "Lancashire County Council (Wyre Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
  - i. Item (309) b) (xv) of Schedule 10.01;
  - ii. Item (11) (i) of Schedule 12.084;
  - iii. Item (21) b) (ix) of Schedule 14.33.
- d. The "Lancashire County Council (Church Street and New Market Street, Colne, Pendle Borough) (Part Revocation, Disabled Parking Place, Prohibition of Waiting and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2012" insofar as it relates to:
  - i. Schedule 2;
  - ii. Item 1. Of Schedule 3;
  - iii. Item 1. Of Schedule 4.
- e. The whole of Schedule 2 to the "Lancashire County Council (Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, Wyre, Borough) (Part Revocation, Limited Waiting, Buses Only) Order 2013";
- f. Item 2 of Schedule 3 of the "Lancashire County Council (Inner Promenade, Lytham, Fylde Borough) (Revocation and Limited Waiting) Order 2015" insofar as it relates to Inner Promenade from a point 39 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Lake Road for a distance of 33 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
  - a. Church Street, Colne, the north side, from a point 74.5 metres east of its junction with the centre line of New Market Street, for a distance of 29 metres in an easterly direction;
  - b. Church Street, Colne, the north side, from its junction with the centre line of New Market Street, for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction;
  - c. Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 65 metres west of its junction with the centre line of Slater Road to its junction with the centreline of Kings Road in a westerly direction.
- 3. Introduce a restriction of waiting between 8am and 7pm in the following lengths of road:
  - a. Lawson Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 45 metres north from its junction with the centreline of Tenterfield Street for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction;
  - b. Lawson Street, Preston, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Tenterfield Street for a distance of 10.5 metres in a northerly direction.

- 4. Introduce a restriction of loading Monday to Saturday between 10am and 4pm in Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 65 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Slater Road to its junction with the centreline of Kings Road in a westerly direction.
- Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 1 hour, no return within 2 hours, Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 7pm in Church Street, Colne, the north side, from a point 47 metres north-east of its junction with the centre line of New Market Street for a distance of 20 metres in an easterly direction.
- 6. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 1 hour, no return within 2 hours, Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm in Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 34 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Slater Road for a distance of 19 metres in a westerly direction.
- 7. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes, no return within 1 hour between 8am and 7pm in Lawson Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 14.1 metres north from its junction with the centreline of Tenterfield Street for a distance of 28.8 metres in a northerly direction to cover 8 echelon bays.
- 8. Introduce a bus limited waiting parking place, for 1 hour, no return within 1 hour, Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm in Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 17.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Kings Road for a distance of 26 metres in a westerly direction.
- 9. Introduce an electric vehicle charging point parking place, for 1 hour, no return within 2 hours, in the following lengths of road:
  - a. Kay Street, Rawtenstall, the south west side, from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with the centre line of North Street for a distance of 10 metres in a north-westerly direction;
  - b. Lawson Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 10.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Tenterfield Street for the length of the first echelon bay (3.6 metres) in a northerly direction.
- 10. Introduce an electric vehicle charging point parking place, for 3 hours, no return within 2 hours, in the following lengths of road:
  - a. Bury Road, Haslingden, the north east side, from a point 21.5 metres south-east of its junction with the centre line of Church Street for a distance of 21 metres in a south-easterly direction;
  - b. Church Street, Colne, the north side, from a point 14 metres north-east of its junction with the centre line of New Market Street for a distance of 33 metres in a north-easterly direction;
  - c. Inner Promenade, Lytham St Annes, the south side, from a point 39 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Lake Road for a distance of 33 metres in an easterly direction;
  - d. Kay Street, Rawtenstall, the south west side, from a point 15 metres north-west of its junction with the centre line of North Street, for a distance of 22 metres in a north-westerly direction;
  - e. King Street, Bacup, the east side, from a point 13 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Lee Street for a distance of 22 metres in a northerly direction;
  - f. Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 10 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Slater Road for a distance of 24 metres in a westerly direction.
- 11. Introduce a taxi stand in Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys, the south side, from a point 53 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Slater Road for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.
- 12. Introduce a disabled person's parking place on Church Street, Colne, the north side, from a point 67 metres north-east of its junction with the centreline of New Market Street for a distance of 7.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
