- a) Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Preston Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to Items (328) b), (328) c) (i) and (328) c) (ii).
- b) Amend the "Lancashire County Council (The Whole of Lancashire) (Revocation and Designation of on Street Parking Charges) Order 2015" as amended as below:

- c) Amend the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Preston City Area) (Revocation and Introduction of Parking Places) Order 2015" as amended as below:
 - a) Insert a new Schedule 19 "Pay and Display Parking 8am 6pm max Stay 4 Hours No Return within 1 Hour on roads in Preston City"
 - b) Insert the following information into the newly inserted Schedule 19:

- 4) Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Pitt Street, Preston, the west side, from a point 25 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Arthur Street for a distance of 72.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - b) Pitt Street, Preston, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Ribble Street for a distance of 73 metres in a northerly direction, then 12 metres in a south easterly direction.
- 5) Introduce a prohibition of loading/unloading in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Pitt Street, Preston, the west side, from a point 25 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Arthur Street for a distance of 72.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - b) Pitt Street, Preston, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Ribble Street for a distance of 73 metres in a northerly direction, then 12 metres in a south easterly direction.
