Executive Summary

To delegate the powers of the Director of Public Health to relevant officers.

Reason for Urgency

This decision is urgent and cannot await the next meeting of Cabinet on 3 September 2020. The reason for this is to ensure the County Council can exercise its full range of powers under the regulations to tackle the spread of coronavirus. This decision is therefore being taken on behalf of Cabinet by the Leader of the Council in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order C16(1).

Recommendation

The Leader of the Council is asked to approve that all powers in relation to COVID-19 that are the responsibility of the Director for Public Health and Wellbeing, including, but not limited to, any necessary actions in relation to the COVID-19 Local Outbreak Plan for Lancashire, be delegated to the Public Health Consultants.

This decision should be implemented immediately for the purposes of Standing Order C29 as any delay could adversely affect the execution of the County council's responsibilities in relation to its ability to meet the requirements of the relevant Coronavirus regulations to help prevent the spread of the virus in Lancashire.

At its meeting on 6 August 2020, Cabinet agreed arrangements for the exercise of the new powers provided under the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (England) (No. 3) Regulations 2020.
