- 1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Locations, Wyre, Pendle, Rossendale and Fylde Boroughs, and Preston City) (Revocations, Various Restrictions and Electric Vehicle Charging Points (No2))Order 2020" insofar as it relates to:
 - a) Item a) of Schedule 9;
 - b) Items a), d), and e) of Schedule 10.
- 2. Introduce an electric vehicle parking place for 3 hours with no return within 2 hours in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Bury Road, Haslingden, the north east side, from a point 11 metres south-east of its junction with the centreline of Church Street for a distance of 36 metres in a south-easterly direction;
 - b) Kay Street, Rawtenstall, the south west side, from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with the centreline of North Street for a distance of 32 metres in a north-westerly direction;
 - c) King Street, Bacup, the east side, from a point 22 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Lee Street for a distance of 22.5 metres in a northerly direction.
