## **Executive Summary**

The addition of Hanson Cement Liaison Committee to the county council's list of outside bodies and the appointment of a county council representative to Hanson Cement Liaison Committee.

#### Recommendation

Cabinet is asked to approve:

- (i) The addition of Hanson Cement Liaison Committee to the list of outside bodies to which the county council makes appointments.
- (ii) Subject to (i) above, the appointment of County Councillor Sue Hind as the county council's representative to Hanson Cement Liaison Committee until the next county council elections in 2025.

#### **Background and Advice**

Hanson Cement is a leading supplier of building materials based in Clitheroe. The role of Hanson Cement Liaison Committee is to keep Ribble Valley Borough Council, Parish Councils, local residents and Lancashire County Council up-to-date on issues at Hanson Cement. The Liaison Committee meets twice a year and a county councillor from the local area is required to sit on the Committee.

Appointments to outside bodies are normally considered and approved by Cabinet every four years following a county council election. The Director of Corporate Services is authorised, in consultation with the Deputy Leader of the County Council, to approve in year appointments and changes. However, as Hanson Cement is



required to be added to the list of outside bodies to which the county council appoints, approval by Cabinet is necessary.

Approval is therefore requested for Hanson Cement Liaison Committee to be added to the county council's list of Outside Bodies and for County Councillor Sue Hind to be appointed as the county council's representative to Hanson Cement Liaison Committee, until the next county council elections in 2025.
