Title of Report: Lancashire Complex Children's Home Capital Bid

Brief Description:

This report outlines the county council's capital bid to the Department for Education to establish a regulated solo/dual home for children with the most complex needs, and sets out proposals for the capital investment that would be required for match funding should the bid be successful.

The reason for this is due to the deadline for applications to the Department for Education's Children's Homes Capital Fund.
