


Business Board Core Principles

- Advisory, scrutiny, intelligence functionality
- Linked to CCA
- Retains strengths and rationalizes structures of as is LEP
- Absorbs ongoing LEP integration functions and other business boards
 - Business Support
 - Skills and Employment
 - LVEP
 - Producing and Updating Lancashire's Economic Strategy
 - Oversight Growth Hub (mandated)
 - Oversight Careers Hub (mandated)
 - Investment Panel inc. scrutiny of GPF decisions
 - Inward Investment private sector sense check and advocacy

Twice yearly Business Conference

Ensures cross pollination between private sector business and public sector policy setting to ensure ongoing communication of needs and limitations.

Private Sector: Business membership organisations – Large and small employers – business infrastructure representatives

Public sector: Council members planning & infrastructure officers -University reps

Decision Making and Timeline

- This is a decision which needs to be agreed by the three UTLAs as part of their CCA negotiations
- LEP Board wants to debate on 20th September and will have views
- Timetable to advertise for Chair then vacant positions on new Business Board needs to be delivered by calendar year end
- DLUHC are now indicating that they intend to ask areas for a LEP integration plan and would be looking for an identifiable LEP structure to still be in place and spending LEP resource until year end or until the establishment of a shadow CCA.
