

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(WHEATFIELD MEWS AND WHEATFIELD STREET,**  
**LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (REVOCATION AND**  
**PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202\***



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 26 October 2023 and 23 November 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

- a) Remove Item a) of Schedule 2 - Wheatfield Mews, Lancaster, both sides, from its junction with Wheatfield Street for a distance of 231 metres in a southerly direction.
- b) Introduce the following:
  - a) Wheatfield Mews, Lancaster, the west side, from its junction with Wheatfield Street for a distance of 231 metres in a southerly direction;
  - b) Wheatfield Mews, Lancaster, the east side, from its junction with Wheatfield Street for a distance of 59.5 metres in a southerly direction;
  - c) Wheatfield Mews, Lancaster, the east side, from a point 210 metres from its junction with Wheatfield Street for a distance of 21 metres in a southerly direction.

**Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this modification is to address concerns raised from the residents in relation to accessing their properties. The modification addresses these concerns, without this being detrimental to vehicle movements along the street.
