Brief Summary

This report presents an application from a local organisation requesting £2,000 towards the cost of signage at their football grounds from the Local Member Grants Scheme.

The organisation has submitted a multi-division application requesting a total amount of £2,000 from the Local Member Grants Scheme towards the same project. Requests have been made to each of the following county councillors and a separate report will be submitted to each councillor for their determination:

- County Councillor Carole Haythornthwaite - £500
- County Councillor Noordad Aziz - £500
- County Councillor Munsif Dad BEM JP - £500
- County Councillor Loraine Cox - £500

Recommendation

That consideration be given to the request for grant funding as set out in this report.

Detail

On 16 December 2021, Full Council approved the reintroduction of the Local Member Grants Scheme. Under the scheme, each county councillor has been given a specific budget which they can spend to enhance the economic, social, and environmental well-being of people who live in their division. Following the



reintroduction, using powers in the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, the Leader of the County Council has authorised individual county councillors to take formal decisions on behalf of the county council.

For the financial year 2024/25, each county councillor has a budget of £2000. Each councillor can also carry forward a maximum of £200 that was unspent in the previous financial year. County Councillor Munsif Dad's total budget is set out in the financial section of the report.

Accrington Stanley, a founding member of the Football League in 1888, has established a longstanding relationship with the local community, and it's a symbol of civic pride.

OASST's outstanding work and projects have made a significant impact on the local community. They serve as the voice and body of the fans to bring about positive changes within the football club. Their latest project aims to erect signage around the football stadium to assist visiting fans with navigation around the club site.

The funds will benefit the people in the councillor's division by improving the experience of all visitors travelling to the club from throughout the borough, thus maximising the use of the football club's facilities.
