Brief Summary

This report presents an application from a local organisation requesting £600 towards the cost of a special bag for every choir member and publication of poetry books to mark the choir's 3rd anniversary from the Local Member Grants Scheme.

The organisation has submitted a multi-division application requesting a total amount of £600 from the Local Member Grants Scheme towards the same project. Requests have been made to each of the following county councillors and a separate report will be submitted to each councillor for their determination:

- County Councillor Peter Buckley £100
- County Councillor Stephen Clarke £100
- County Councillor Andrea Kay £200
- County Councillor John Shedwick £200

Recommendation

The Cabinet Member for Community and Culture Services is requested to consider and approve the request for grant funding as set out in the report.

Detail

On 16 December 2021, Full Council approved the reintroduction of the Local Member Grants. Under the scheme, each county councillor has been given a specific budget which they can spend to enhance the economic, social, and environmental well-being of people who live in their division. Following the reintroduction, using powers in the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, the Leader of the County Council has authorised individual county councillors to take formal decisions on behalf of the county council.

The above legislation however does not apply to Cabinet Members as they already have these decision-making powers. The Cabinet Member for Community and Cultural Services is therefore being asked to consider and agree the application for funding (in relation to their own Local Member Grants Scheme budget) under the existing decision-making process for Cabinet (Executive) Members. Existing rules for executive decision making, including the notification of key decisions and provision for the call in of decisions will therefore continue to apply for Cabinet Members.

For the financial year 2024/25, each county councillor has a budget of £2000. Each councillor can also carry forward a maximum of £200 that was unspent in the previous financial year. County Councillor Peter Buckley's total budget is set out in the financial section of the report.

We would like to purchase a special bag for everyone in the choir to enable them to bring their music to rehearsal and concerts in a uniformed style.

The choir are also having a poetry book published to mark their 3rd anniversary. We have £348.49 in restricted funds for the publication, however the design and print

costs is £710.

These are going to be handmade and the sewing will commence once any funding request is successful.
How will the money benefit people in the councillor(s) division(s)?
The choir is made up of 80 members from Fylde (18.24%), Wyre (81.25%) and Blackpool (0.5%). The choir pay subs and support the work of the choir, attending rehearsals and performing in each of the boroughs.
The choir purchase their own uniform and music folder at the moment, and it will be very professional if every member has their own music bag.

100 bags at £8.50 = £850 Publication of poetry books = £350 £600 is a contribution towards this total cost.
