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Brief Summary

This paper presents the Lancashire and South Cumbria Integrated Care System's Urgent and Emergency Care 5-year draft strategy, as set out at Appendix 'A'.

The purpose of the strategy is to guide how urgent and emergency care services are transformed over the next five years to enable people to easily access the right care and support which meets their needs. It describes the challenges and the opportunities for the future, and it sets out the vision and priorities.

It should be noted that the draft strategy, which at the time of writing this paper is still under development, is scheduled to be considered for approval at the Integrated Care Board's (ICB) Board meeting on 11 September 2024.

Recommendation

The Health and Wellbeing Board is asked to review the report and discuss the progress made on developing the strategy.

Detail

At the meeting on 3 September 2024, there will be a presentation that provides more detail on the process undertaken, including: the background; the vision, aims and priorities; the engagement activities undertaken; and the key changes that are currently being made to improve the strategy.
