Executive Summary

The Lancashire and South Cumbria ICS Joint Forward Plan (JFP) for 2023 onwards was agreed by the ICB Board in July 2023. Prior to its publication in July 2023, there had been wide engagement with Trust Boards, Health and Well-being Boards, the Integrated Care Partnership and the public on the development of the strategic priorities set out in the plan.

Given the five-year scope of the plan, there is a requirement under statute for the JFP to be refreshed each year, so a further iteration of the plan was published, following LSC ICB Board approval in July 2024.

Discussions concluded that there should not be a full rewrite of the JFP for 2024 as that there was no intention to shift the plan away from previously agreed strategic priorities. This allowed for a light-touch refresh of the original plan, which focused on;

- progress against implementation during 2023/24
- any additions or change in direction for the new 'year 5' of the plan
- updates in relation to a number of developing system initiatives, including the New Hospitals Programme, development of place based partnerships and their local work programmes, Recovery and Transformation programme and key enabler strategies.

Contributions from across the ICB and wider system have been woven into the refreshed Joint Forward Plan for 2024 onwards.
