Executive Summary

In January 2024 members of Lancashire & South Cumbria Integrated Care Partnership (ICP) gave their support to the development of a Vanguard Bid to the national WorkWell programme. An application was submitted in February 2024 and we received confirmation that the bid had been successful in June 2024.

This paper provides members with an update on progress being made to mobilise the programme, the governance arrangements being put in place and the opportunity for leadership and direction from the ICP on this important agenda. It is proposed that a future ICP 'Deep Dive' workshop session is dedicated to work & health in order to explore this agenda in more detail and to capitalise on collaborative opportunities that will lead to improvements in outcomes for our residents and communities.
