

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(HARRY POTTS WAY, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMP
AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

1. That in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a road hump in Harry Potts Way, Burnley, from a point 31.7 metres west of its junction with Higgin Street for a distance of 18.4 metres in a westerly direction.
The road hump will have a maximum height not exceeding 75mm.
2. That in accordance with Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a zebra crossing in Harry Potts Way, Burnley, from a point 33.4 metres west of its junction with Higgin Street for a distance of 15.7 metres in a westerly direction.
