Brief Summary

To consider a request from the committee to establish a deep dive session and working group on the emerging SEND Strategy for 2025-2028.

(The reason for the report being presented as an item of urgent business to Scrutiny Management Board is the need to expedite the matter and facilitate in-depth scrutiny in contributing to the development of the strategy during the further consultation and workshops stage in January 2025).

Recommendation
