Care Leaver Covenant

- The Care Leaver Covenant (CLC) is part of the government's keep on caring strategy to support people leaving care to become independent. It allows public, private and voluntary sector organisations to pledge support, including:
 - Apprenticeships;
 - Work Experience; and,
 - Free or discounted goods and services.
- All support given through CLC will help care leavers to make a transition to independence. This ranges from CV training to accommodation for care leavers in higher education. Every care leaver has a personal adviser who can provide information on CLC offers. CLC compliments the offers that local authorities make to care leavers.

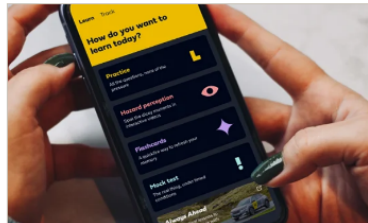

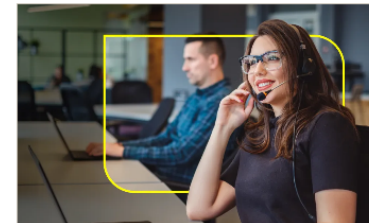
