Brief Summary

This report presents an application from a local organisation requesting £500 towards subsidising a Year 6 residential trip from the Local Member Grants Scheme.

The organisation has submitted a multi-division application requesting a total amount of £1800 from the Local Member Grants Scheme towards the same project. Requests have been made to each of the following county councillors and a separate report will be submitted to each councillor for their determination:

- County Councillor Steven Holgate - £187.50
- County Councillor Kim Snape – £187.50
- County Councillor Alan Cullens - £125

Recommendation

That consideration be given to the request for grant funding as set out in this report.

Detail

On 16 December 2021, Full Council approved the reintroduction of the Local Member Grants Scheme. Under the scheme, each county councillor has been given a specific budget which they can spend to enhance the economic, social, and environmental well-being of people who live in their division. Following the reintroduction, using powers in the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, the Leader of the County Council has authorised individual county councillors to take formal decisions on behalf of the county council.

For the financial year 2024/25, each county councillor has a budget of £2000. Each councillor can also carry forward a maximum of £200 that was unspent in the previous financial year. County Councillor Steven Holgate's total budget is set out in the financial section of the report.

The reduction in the costs to families will be made available to 4 families in this year group who are currently entitled to Pupil Premium and without this support cannot afford for their child to attend this residential.

£500.00 – The cost for the trip to Robin Wood costs £250.00 per child and includes all	



outdoor activities, food and accommodation. The monies will be used to provide 50% funding support to 4 families to enable them to afford for their child to participate in the important milestone at the end of their primary school journey.
