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Brief Summary

On Monday 2 December 2024, the Integrated Care Board (ICB) on behalf of the NHS in Lancashire and South Cumbria announced the proposed sites for a replacement Royal Lancaster Infirmary (RLI, University Hospitals of Morecambe Bay NHS Foundation Trust) and a replacement Royal Preston Hospital (RPH, Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust). This report seeks to provide the Committee with an opportunity to consider the proposed engagement activity.

Recommendation

The Health and Adult Services Scrutiny Committee is asked to consider:

- i. The proposed programme of engagement commencing in mid-January and ending in mid-March 2025.
- ii. The proposed scale of public engagement activity and the level of leadership commitment required.
