**Brief Summary**

This report presents an application from a local organisation requesting £2,000 towards the cost of groundwork for a new playground from the Local Member Grants Scheme.

The organisation has submitted a multi-division application requesting a total amount of £2,000 from the Local Member Grants Scheme towards the same project. Requests have been made to each of the following county councillors and a separate report will be submitted to each councillor for their determination:

- County Councillor Michael Green - £1,000
- County Councillor David Howarth - £500
- County Councillor Barrie Yates - £500

**Recommendation**

That consideration be given to the request for grant funding as set out in this report.

**Detail**

On 16 December 2021, Full Council approved the reintroduction of the Local Member Grants Scheme. Under the scheme, each county councillor has been given a specific budget which they can spend to enhance the economic, social, and environmental well-being of people who live in their division. Following the reintroduction, using powers in the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, the Leader of the County Council has authorised individual county councillors to take formal decisions on behalf of the county council.



For the financial year 2024/25, each county councillor has a budget of £2000. Each councillor can also carry forward a maximum of £200 that was unspent in the previous financial year. County Councillor Barrie Yates' total budget is set out in the financial section of the report.

<p>We are seeking to replace our condemned playground to create a safe and inclusive space for all children. Our school serves a diverse community, and the play area is vital for children of all ages and backgrounds. This project will provide invaluable opportunities for physical, social, and emotional development. To achieve this, we need to raise £30,000 in total. The grant money will specifically fund the initial groundwork, which is estimated at £11,000. Your support will help us take the first step toward transforming this essential space for our children.</p>

<p>We are initially looking to benefit our own children and families within the school but we are looking to expand the use to British Aerospace families additionally, this is currently in discussion.</p>

We need £11,000 overall for groundwork to complete phase 1 of our project, this includes removal of the equipment currently on the ground, flooring (inclusive of safe disposal), levelling off the ground, laying foundations and the implementing of the astroturf and some basic equipment.

£2000 would be put towards our current raised funds. We currently have £7000, and we are looking to add another £1000 to that in December with further events planned for the new year to continue to build.

As above, we currently have £7000 for the project.
