

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BOLTON ROAD AND CHORLEY ROAD, CHORLEY)
(REMOVAL AND INTRODUCTION OF BUS STOP CLEARWAYS)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following:

1. Remove bus stops in the following locations:
 - a) Bolton Road, Anderton, the north side, from a point 23 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Dryfield Lane;
 - b) Chorley Road, Adlington, the north east side, from a point 18 metres southeast of its junction with the centreline of Daisy Hill Drive;
 - c) Chorley Road, Adlington, the south west side, from a point 45 metres northwest of its junction with the projected centreline of Daisy Hill Drive.

2. Introduce Bus Stop Clearways at any time (the effect of which will be to prohibit the stopping of vehicles) in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Bolton Road, Adlington, the south west side, from a point 50 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Rossendale Drive for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - b) Bolton Road, Anderton, the north side, from a point 46 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Dryfield Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction;
 - c) Bolton Road, Anderton, the north side, from a point 264 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Shawes Drive for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction;
 - d) Bolton Road, Anderton, the north east side, from a point 22 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Roscoe Lowe Brow for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - e) Bolton Road, Anderton, the south side, from a point 72 metres west of its junction with the projected centreline of Dryfield Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a westerly direction;
 - f) Bolton Road, Anderton, the south side, from a point 156 metres east of its junction with the projected centreline of Shawes Drive for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction;
 - g) Bolton Road, Anderton, the south west side, from a point 57 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Grimeford Lane for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - h) Bolton Road, Chorley, the north east side, from a point 21 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Yarrow Gate for a distance of 27 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - i) Bolton Road, Chorley, the south west side, from a point 40 metres south east of its junction with the projected centreline of Beechwood Road for a distance of 29 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - j) Bolton Road, Heath Charnock, the west side, from a point 167 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Martin's Avenue for a distance of 27 metres in a north westerly direction;
 - k) Chorley Road, Adlington, the north east side, from a point 53.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Daisy Hill Drive for a distance of 23 metres in a south easterly direction;
 - l) Chorley Road, Adlington, the south west side, from a point 35 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Mount Pleasant for a distance of 23 metres in a north westerly direction;
 - m) Chorley Road, Heath Charnock, the south west side, from a point 53 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of The Asshawes (North junction) for a distance of 27 metres in a north westerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the proposals are to facilitate the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians, providing Equality Act (2010) compliant bus stops. The introduction of Bus Stop Clearways will prevent parked vehicles from obstructing kerbside boarding / alighting and improve bus journey times and consistency.

The proposals also remove three bus stops, relocating these to more appropriate locations and extends one existing bus stop clearway (by 8 metres) to allow the buses to pull in and out safely.
